

How to donate to Edridge



If you want to donate by a regular monthly amount, you can do so on line via our donation facility with **JustGiving**.com. This is completely secure and saves a lot of time and postage: it is also easier for Edridge.

To do this simply go to our website homepage - www.edridgefund.org and click on the button below



You will be taken to the JustGiving.com Website. Just click on **Monthly Donations** and follow the instructions. You will be asked to create a JustGiving account for yourself, which means you can control your donation, or even cancel it, without any difficulty. The link takes you to the Edridge page. You can also make single donations.

What can Edridge do for you ?



Your spend your working life helping other people, but when it comes to your own stuff you put your head in the sand and hope something will turn up.

Everyone needs someone to turn to when life gets difficult to handle. Probation and CAFCASS staff are no exception – and that's where we come in.

The fund is available to help all those eligible for membership of Napo, retired staff and in certain circumstances dependants of people who are eligible . Actual membership is not required.

Edridge gives £30,000 - £50,000 a year to people like you who need it, so don't be afraid to ask. Application is strictly confidential. You can apply direct to the Edridge Office, or seek help from your local Edridge Fund representative.

The fund is primarily used to make one-off crisis payments. We help people of all ages with widely differing needs.

Grants

Donations

Although many people are generous, and give on a regular basis, as well as running Fund Raising events, our income continues to be less than the amount we pay in grants. In recent years we have seen a marked increase in the

Beneficiaries

Our grants to Napo members remain at about the same level as in previous years, which is usually something above 70% of the total. We are likely to have paid out more to Napo members than we receive in the Napo Grant by the end of the year once again.

Reserves

The position of the Fund is quite safe as the Trustees have been able to draw down some funds from time to time from our Investment Portfolio, but this is not a long term solution.

THE SOLUTION

What we really need is regular small monthly donations. If enough people just give us the price of two cups of coffee per month our problem would be solved !
